### REPORT

Guest lecture on 'Significance of forensic Evidence in Crime Investigation' was organised on 04/10/2023 from 10.30 AM to 12.30 PM. Sri. Phaneendar B.N. was invited as a resource person for the programme. The session was commenced by welcome address and a brief introduction of the resource person.

Sri. Phaneendar spoke about meaning and need of forensic evidence in the court matters and perceptions of analysing of forensic evidence relating crime. The resource person in detail explained about the domain of forensic science which includes Forensic science biology, digital forensic, DNA analysis, blood samples, linguistic, behavioural science etc. Sri. Phaneendar explained about cases which was handled by him like suicide note written on the body of the deceased person, handwritten mismatch, stamp paper manipulation, etc. he also explained about various types of digital forensic evidences like SMS, whatsapp, email, audio, video, images, photos, etc which can be produced before the court to do justice to the victim. During the session he shared samples of audio verification, audio speaker identification, video verification, photograph verification for the better understanding of forensic evidence. He also said that due to procedural aspects, trial in criminal cases will be dragged for years and sometime few evidences will be destroyed by criminals. He meticulously explained about the recent financial frauds which are taking place in India and how it can be tackled by forensic experts to curb such financial crimes in the economy. He also explained about the role of forensic expert in various sectors like banking, law firms, audit firms, insurance, corporate, housing & credits, investments, customs etc. he also shared the job opportunities available for forensic experts in directorate of forensic science, intelligence bureau, CBI, etc.

B.M.S College of Law in association with Vakeela Vaahini organised guest lecture on "General Principles of Criminal liability" on 21/07/2023. Sri. Trivikram S.S., Advocate was invited as a resource person to address students. The resource person meticulously dealt with elements of criminal liability such as mens rea and actus reus and its application while imposing criminal liability. He also explained about hierarchy of criminal courts which includes magistrate court, court of session as trial courts which conducts trial of criminal cases. He also explained about the inherent powers of High Courts exercised under section 482 of Cr.P.C to dispose criminal matters.

Sri. Trivikram in detail discussed about general exception clauses under IPC which includes intoxication, act of child, private defence. During the session, he explained about how FIR is lodged, if it is not accepted by police authority complaint can be filed before magistrate or before the superior police officer of the jurisdiction, types of punishments, procedure under Cr P C to conduct trail in criminal matters. The resource person also explained about offences relating to human body, elections, religions, child, provisions of JJ Act and applications of other criminal laws such as Dowry Prohibition Act, POCSO Act, etc.

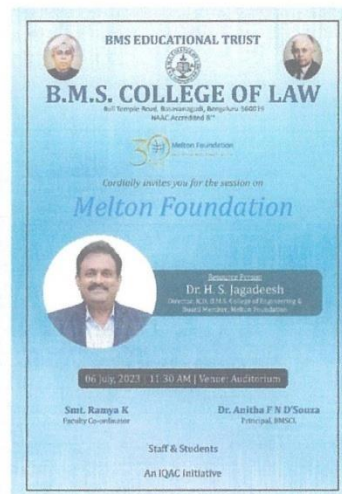

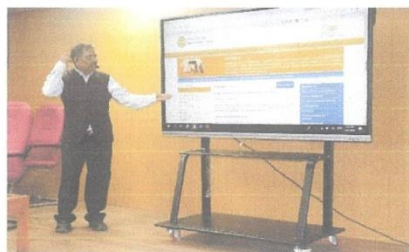
A guest lecture on "Banking Sector in India" was organised to create the awareness regarding Banking operations in India, on 21 June, 2023 at 2:00 PM.

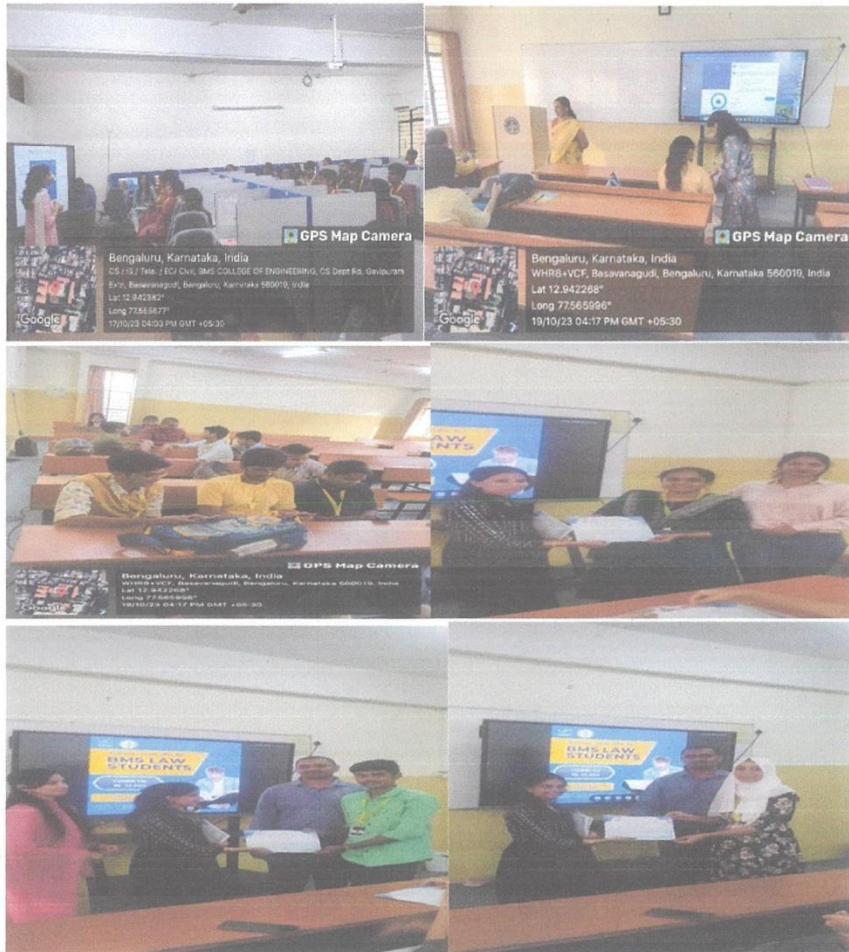

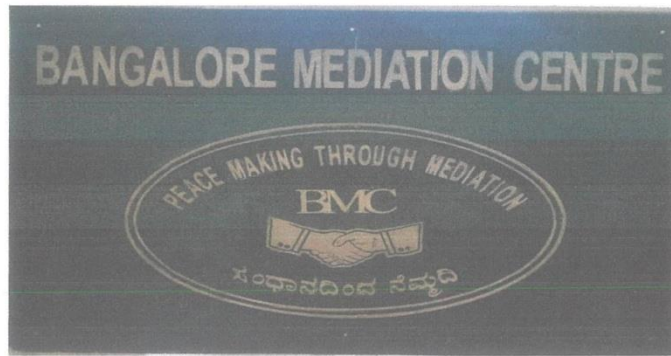

Overall, Session covered Judicial recognition, steps of mediation, areas covered, and enforceability. The resource person also highlighted the mediation procedure and also spoke about why mediation is treated as a party-centric process. How confidentiality is maintained. Why mediator is called as a facilitator. She also shared her personal experiences in her professional life as an advocate and as a mediator. The entire procedure of conduct was explained by the resource person as to how case is referred based on request of parties or by judge's opinion; slots are allotted; party autonomous process; welcoming of parties; sessions which may include both joint as well as private; idea of rephrasing and reframing by mediator; principles of mediation that leads to finding a common ground of understanding by parties and so on.

The Mediator introduced to the various Alternative Dispute resolution mechanisms and in depth explained the procedural aspects of the Mediation process. The Mediator highlighted the following points in her lecture: Win-Win situation in mediation is the key to its success. Two kinds of sessions which take place in mediation -Private session (Caucus) and joint session respectively. She briefly explained how private sessions provide an opportunity for the parties to have one-on-one discussions with the mediator. Another, undeniably, important aspect of mediation is that it is completely confidential. The process of mediation as the intervention into a dispute by an impartial and neutral third party - party centric process. Mediator does not play the role of a judge, just a facilitator, the disputing parties voluntarily agree upon settlement of issues in dispute.

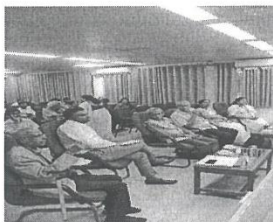
