It highlighted upon various career opportunities available in the form of placements in reputed firms, NGOs, litigation and academia.

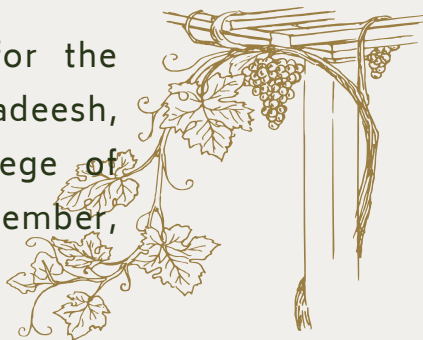


MELTON FOUNDATION

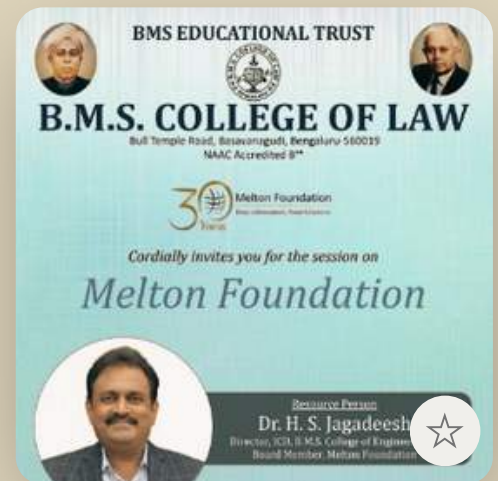
